National Institute for International Education

is a national agency under the Ministry of Education, established for education of overseas Koreans and international education exchanges and cooperations. It is responsible for planning, selecting, administering and evaluating Korean Homeland Education.



Kongju National University

is a university that fosters secondary school teachers. The University established the Institution of Korean Culture & Education specializing in the education of overseas Koreans.

The Institution is in charge of operating (classes and students) domestic education programs for overseas Koreans.

? What is Korean Homeland Education?

'Korean Homeland Education (K-HED)' is an education program for overseas Koreans made to cultivate the ethnic identity of overseas Koreans and help next-generation overseas Koreans to grow into global talents. This program comprises the Korean language, Korean culture, and Korean history classes, as well as field learning. K-HED is the only long-term education program for overseas Koreans in the nation that provides career guidance and a network of overseas Koreans.

● NIIED Scholarship

National Scholarship

- **Beneficiaries:** Applicants for the Korean Homeland Education who have recommendation by an overseas embassy or consulate
- **Selection criteria:** Review and selection by 'Scholarship Committee' considering academic enthusiasm, future prospect, economic need, descendant of an Independence Patriot, etc., among those with the recommendation by an overseas embassy or consulate
- **Content of support:** Around 70% of the educational expenses and round-trip air fare for the applied course (one course)
- **No. of beneficiaries:** Around 350 students a year

※ In a case of a descendant of an Independent Patriot, 100% of the educational expenses and round-trip air fare is supported when selected for scholarship.
